RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Carrot Cake



This is a great recipe. One piece is never enough! It can be made in two smaller tins or one larger one – and it freezes well.

1 cup vegetable oil
1 cup caster sugar
3 eggs
1½ cups plain flour
2 teaspoons cinnamon
1 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda
1½ teaspoons baking powder
½ cup chopped walnuts
2 cups grated carrots
Pinch of salt

Icing:
125 grams Philadelphia Cream Cheese
25 grams butter
2 cups icing sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla

Beat oil, sugar and eggs for 4-5 minutes until light and creamy.

Sift flour, cinnamon, Bicarb Soda, baking powder and salt into the mixture (don't mix at this stage)

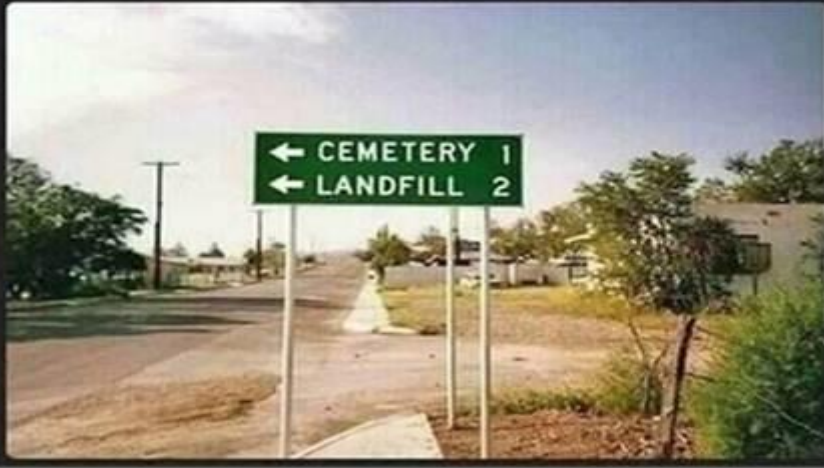
Add walnuts and carrot.

Fold in added ingredients carefully until mixture is well combined.

Place in a large greased and lined lamington tin (27cm x 17cm) and bake in a moderate oven (180 degrees Celsius) for about 25 minutes. When tested with a skewer it should come out clean. Allow to cool.

Icing: Beat softened Cream cheese, butter and vanilla together, then add the icing sugar, one cup at a time, and beat until smooth. Spread on cooled cake and sprinkle with crushed nuts and a little cinnamon. Enjoy!!
