

We also had a new sound system company, and I have received good feedback from the quality of the sound set-up. As I said earlier the Service was very well attended – so much so that our 75 chairs did not meet the requirements of the attendance. At our post Service review, we identified this as a problem and will be hiring extra chairs in 2025.

The Auxiliary – with the support of some of the Committee members set-up a table in The Ary from November 6 to November 10 to sell Poppy badges and pens etc. Bev Pritchatt and Christine Sellers with the support of Secretary Judith Walker and a few of the Committee raised \$999 in the five days. Well done to all involved.

Merchant Mariners Day is on again on Saturday 7 December at Norah Head Lighthouse. Toukley RSL sub=Branch has again been invited to participate in this Commemorative Service. The Committee have already committed to attending and if any members would like to attend the bus will leave the front of The Ary at 10.00 am



AUXILIARY REPORT – November 2024

Only two Auxiliary members attended the Remembrance Day Service this year. Auxiliary assistance was provided to the Sub-Branch by handing out service booklets, bottles of water, assistance to the public in attendance when required, and handing out cold drinks and ice blocks/ice creams to children at the end of the service.

At the Remembrance Day stall conducted between the $6^{th} - 10^{th}$ November at the ARY, a total of \$842.00 was raised by the Auxiliary and Sub-Branch volunteers that manned the stall. This was an outstanding effort.

I would personally like to thank Bev Pritchatt for the extra effort that was required, to amend the roster several times due to the 'last minute' unavailability of Auxiliary members, including spending extra time at the stall; and to Denise Humphries, who despite difficulties with managing family health issues for some time, makes herself available time and time again.

In addition to the Remembrance Day stall, the ARY Reception staff rostered on at the time Donna, advised the Sub-Branch Secretary that several of the general public coming into the ARY were asking to buy Poppies and other Remembrance Day memorabilia. A decision was made that several poppy badges etc would be sold at the ARY Reception desk. On behalf of the Auxiliary, I would like to thank Donna for taking the initiative to assist the public with their requests, and helping to take the overall monies raised to \$999.00.

As mentioned in our previous report, Joan Kennedy, myself and Bev Pritchatt (as backup) were nominated to plan the Sub Branch Wellness bus trips; it was also stated, that sheets of paper would be passed around at the Sub Branch General meeting to give members the opportunity to put their names down for recommended trips, and to make suggestions for trips that the members would like to nominate. Sheets with suggested trips were distributed around the room at the September General meeting, but unfortunately, the Auxiliary members present did not receive any sheets with response to trips suggested. Please note, if there are insufficient numbers for a planned trip, it may need to be cancelled.
