<u>Toukley RSL Sub-Branch President's Report presented by</u> <u>Vice President - Mike Humphries with Ian Collier away for</u> the November meeting:



The start of October saw a meeting with Ethinvest — our Financial Advisors — two of the Trustees Milton Porter and Steve Edmunds and I. Max Thom was unavailable as he was on holidays at the time. At this meeting Matthew Hicks the advisor from Ethinvest spoke to the trustees about the balance of our investments and suggested for Toukley RSL Sub-Branch to slightly modify our approach to a more growth accented portfolio. He said this was in keeping with RSL NSW advice and as such it was agreed to by the Trustees. Matthew also suggested — and we were already aware — that we had too much money sitting in a Macquarie Cash account and the Trustees agreed for Matthew to proceed with investing some of this account back into the market.

On Sunday 13 October I attended a Social Bowls day at The Entrance/Long Jetty Sub-Branch accompanied by two of our Auxiliary members in Bev Pritchatt and Midge Scott. A good day and a chance to consolidate our relationship with another of our local sub-Branches.

I have been approached by Trevor Haynes to see if there is any interest in the Sub-Branch hosting a day at Mason's Place. A few of the Directors are looking at ways for the Sub-Branch to receive a bit more exposure and have suggested this. It is early days, but I hope we can take advantage of this opportunity. The day would be promoted as a fun family day and promoted in a way to hopefully attract new members through the family aspect.

On Monday 14 October I chaired the Auxiliary meeting. Bev Pritchatt as acting co-ordinator did a good job in running the agenda and asked for volunteers from the floor to sell Poppy Badges etc for Remembrance Day. The Auxiliary will be set-up in the club from Wednesday 6 November to Sunday 10 November. Any assistance to them would be appreciated.

My grant application to The Mounties Community Grants scheme to cover the cost of the work at Diggers was not successful.

The saga of the VSF funding to the CCVC was finally resolved. The President of the CCVC – Les Jacobs – refused to sign the contract that RSL NSW wanted him to sign before they released the money. There are two sides to this scenario and we now have to live with the end result. The \$28K that we donated to the VSF for the CCVC has been refunded with interest and is now back in our account. We now intend to proceed with the work we had always planned to do – which is build a garage in the backyard at Diggers to put some shelving in to allow the VMCC to move their fridge and other material out of the office at Diggers into the garage.

Friday 25 October saw a bus trip to Mingara to have a look at the club and have Yum Cha at their Chinese Restaurant. If you are attending any proposed trip please put it into your diary to ensure you turn up on the day.

The planning for Remembrance Day on Monday 11 November is well under way. Mike, Roy and Judith have picked up the ball and are running with it. We will have a catafalque party from 236 Army cadets, the choir from Warnervale Public School and a new sound system guy.

Brad Moore from AV electronics who we have used in the past has retired.

Mike Humphries and I attended the RSL State Congress from Sunday 27 to Tuesday 29 October. It was a good opportunity to network with other delegates from around the State. It is a bit of an eye-opener to see how some of these sub-Branches are surviving with the numbers and finance that they have. The issue of affiliate members was canvassed widely at Congress and even though Toukley RSL Sub-Branch remain opposed to the idea in some of the remote areas there would not be a Sub-Branch without affiliate members and this includes holding executive positions. The date for the MEAO commemoration—the Middle East Area of Operation—also had plenty of discussion. It was held for the first time this year on 11 July which is the day our troops withdrew from Afghanistan and the veterans from that campaign do not regard it as an appropriate occasion to be commemorating. It was voted to not use 11 July next near and District Councils will be asked to submit dates they consider more appropriate.

The Committee will be holding an interment service for Ralph Bull on Sunday 1 December at 10.30 am.

And finally tickets for our Annual Wellness and Wellbeing Event (Christmas Party) on Sunday 15th December at 11.00am will be on sale after today's meeting and on Thursday mornings at the Sub-Branch office up until 1 week before the event.

Morning tea with Emma McBride at Wyong Hub Wednesday 23rd October.




